

1. **False.** Read Romans 8:1 - God does not condemn Christians, but gently works in our lives to grow us.
2. **True.** Eph. 1:6 says, "To the praise of the glory of His grace by which He has made us accepted in the Beloved (NKJV).
3. **False.** Read Romans 7:4. Fruit comes from our union with Christ, not from keeping religious rules.
4. **False.** The New Testament calls Christians "saints" 63 times. We still sin at times, but have a new identity now.
5. **True.** Read Ezekiel 36:26 - 27. God has fulfilled His promise to give us a new heart - one which desires to walk in His ways.
6. **True.** Read 1 Thes. 4:24. God will bring to pass all that He has planned for your spiritual life.
